

Site 113 and Site 65 Updated FAQs- October 2020

- 1. How do I know if I am zoned for the new school?** At the 10/13/20 School Board meeting the zoning of Site 113 (Windermere Relief HS) and Site 65 (Bridgewater Relief MS) were finalized. Zoning Option #2 was selected for Site 113 and Option #1 was selected for Site 65. Site 113 will host Site 65 through the 2022-2023 school year.

- 2. Do I need to register for the new school?** If you are a current student at one of our feeder schools and will be zoned for our school you will not need to enroll with our school. Our guidance team will visit our feeder schools (Bridgewater MS, Horizon West MS, and Windermere HS) in January/February 2021 in order to facilitate course registration. There is nothing that these students or parents need to do before that. If you are zoned to attend either Site 113 or Site 65 and are currently attending OCVS, FLVS, other home school program, or a charter or private school, you will need to register with us. Registration will begin in March of 2021; more information will be posted to our website at that time.
- 3. Do I have to attend the new middle or high school or can I remain at Windermere HS or Bridgewater MS?** Students will attend their zoned school. For information about school transfers please visit the [OCPS student enrollment website](#).
- 4. Which grade levels will be at the new school?** Site 113 will serve grades 9-12, however only 9th through 11th graders will attend during the 2021-2022 school year. Seniors will remain at Windermere HS during that year. Our facility will also be the host site for a relief middle school for Bridgewater Middle School referred to as Site 65. Site 65 will be located adjacent to Water Spring Elementary School and is scheduled to open in the 2023-2024 school year serving grades 6-8. In the 2021-2022 and 2022-2023 school years the school will be located on Site 113's campus and be served by the same administration, however each school will be considered its own entity, with Site 65 having its own, name, mascot, and school colors with the school name slated to be voted upon at the December 8th, 2020 OCPS School Board meeting.
- 5. When will counselors be available to discuss course selections?** Counselors will visit feeder schools including Water Spring ES, Bridgewater MS, Horizon West MS, and Windermere HS in order to conduct the course registration process. Counselors will visit each school to facilitate meetings with students to discuss their course selection. Prior to their meeting with students, students will receive a virtual presentation/powerpoint explaining the registration process. 5th and 8th grade presentations will be held in person at BMS, HWMS, and WSES. Classroom visits and meetings will be facilitated in January and February. A schedule will be posted prior to the meetings. We will also facilitate parent nights at our feeder schools in January and early February 2021.
- 6. Is there a course directory or curriculum guide available for review?** Our curriculum guide will be posted to our website in early January.
- 7. When will the school open?** Site 113 and Site 65 will open to students in August of 2021.
- 8. When will I know my schedule for 21-22?** It is anticipated that you will be able to access your schedule in August of 2021.

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9. **How do I get a schedule change or change my requested classes?** If there is a concern or issue with your schedule or requested classes you can submit a response through our google form survey which will be available in late Spring (March). Counselors email addresses will be posted to our website in early January.
10. **What if you don't offer a class I need?** If you are interested in taking a class that we do not offer you should reach out to your counselor to discuss options including alternative courses or platforms. You can either submit our google form or email your counselor at firstname.lastname@ocps.net.
11. **Will you offer Cambridge (AICE) courses and Advanced Placement courses?** We will offer a variety of both AICE/Cambridge as well as Advanced Placement courses. A complete list of courses will be available through our curriculum guide which will be posted on our website in January 2021.
12. **How do I sign up for athletics?** Athletic activities require students to have a current physical form submitted annually in order to participate and try out. Our athletic director will be posting information related to sports on our website starting in late Spring. We anticipate that we will participate in Spring football, all other sports will begin in Fall of 2021.
13. **When will we have a name, mascot, and school colors?** The process for selecting a name, mascot, and school colors has begun and will continue through the fall. The first step of this process was to collect community input on names. We had nearly 1000 responses to our first survey and published a second survey based on 5 of those names submitted. The second survey is a vote for one of the 5 following names: Hamlin HS, Horizon HS, Horizon West HS, Seidel HS, and Winter Garden HS. The second survey was available from 10/14/20 through 10/22/20. It is expected that the Orange County School Board will vote on the final name at the December 8th OCPS School Board meeting.
