



Blankner K-8 Arrival Procedures

Where do students go once they are on campus?

What will children do before school begins?

IF ARRIVING BEFORE 8:00am –

Students must be enrolled in the Dramatic Education Program, if on campus before 8:00am. Dramatic Education students will go to the Cafeteria; parents must sign their child in each morning. In Dramatic Education, students will be engaged in activities such as homework help, reading, arts and crafts, physical movement games, and more. Dramatic Education students may participate in extracurricular activities before school (such as tutoring with their teacher, clubs, chorus etc.) IF the parent has given Dramatic Education permission to release their child AND the student has a pass to the specific location. Morning program passes will be given out by teachers sponsoring the activity.

During Arrival Time (8:00-8:30am), students should proceed to:

IF EATING BREAKFAST AT SCHOOL – students should first go straight to the Cafeteria if eating breakfast at school. Do not stop anywhere else first; it is important that students get breakfast so they have energy and brain power for their learning day! After students finish eating, they will then go to their grade level location.

IF IN KINDERGARTEN – students should go to the Media Center. They will enjoy story time while they wait for their teacher to pick them up at 8:30. Parents, please allow your child to enter on their own; goodbyes may take place at our school doors. Don't worry, your little one is in good hands within our building!

IF IN FIRST GRADE – students should go to the Cafeteria. They will sit at tables, where they may read, draw, or practice writing or math skills while they wait for their teacher to pick them up.

IF IN SECOND OR FIFTH GRADES – students should go to their classroom hallway. Students will sit in grade level sections as they wait for their teacher to pick them up. Students may read, chat with friends, etc.

IF IN THIRD OR FOURTH GRADES – students should go to the gym. Students will sit in grade level sections as they wait for their teacher to pick them up. Students may read, chat with friends, etc.

IF IN MIDDLE SCHOOL – students should go to the butterfly garden. Students may socialize with friends as they wait for the 8:30 bell to ring. Middle school students may ask to go to the Media Center for book check out or assistance with their laptop if needed; permission and morning program pass will be given by the adult on duty at the butterfly garden.

EXTRACURRICULAR MORNING ACTIVITIES –

Students may participate in many extracurricular programs and opportunities. For example, students may opt to be in clubs or may take advantage of teacher-offered tutoring time. For all of these opportunities, the

teacher who is sponsoring the activity will give the student a morning hall pass. This hall pass must be with any student who is in areas of campus other than the assigned grade level locations.
