

6th Grade Parent Information Meeting – FAQ

1. What documentation is needed for special schedule requests?

Documentation is situation specific and determined by the need for the request. Parents making the request are to submit the documentation that indicates there is a need for early departure. The request form is available under the student services tab on our homepage.

2. If I am granted a PE waiver, which options does my child have for an alternative course?

If a PE waiver is granted, students will be enrolled in one of the elective choices submitted during registration.

3. Can a 6th grader take Spanish 1?

No. 6th grade students are offered beginning Spanish and could elect to take Spanish 1 in 7th grade and Spanish 2 in 8th grade.

4. How do I sign my child up for the YMCA before or after school zone?

Parents can access registration information for the YMCA before and after school zone on our school homepage. The YMCA staff will also be available during schedule pickup and “meet the teacher” in August.

5. When will the school supply list be available?

The school supply list will be posted on our homepage and social media account in late July or Early August.

6. When and how can students sign up for clubs?

Club information will be made available to students in September. Students will have the opportunity to register digitally through the school-wide Canvas page at that time.

7. Is there a cheerleading team?
