Principal's Report

- Mr. Swenson presented the Principal's report.

 - It is a purchased curriculum from the company 'Cognito'.
 - There were a few technical issues, however they were corrected and healthy discussions followed that seemed beneficial to the students.
 - There are four more sessions to complete the course

Grant Updates:

1. Physics - Morgan
 - Grant for \$916.70 for friction blocks, pendulums, and photogates to use with the AP Physics 1 and C classes. This grant was approved.

2. Social Studies - McGrew
 - Request for \$2,010 for (120) copies of “The Women’s Atlas” to replace the outdated copies. This grant was amended from its original request of 120 copies to 70 copies. Grant approved for \$\$1,049.30 plus shipping
3. Science - Ebert
 - \$1,579.75 for DNA kits to help students understand the structure of DNA. This grant was unanimously approved.
4. Foreign Language - Rivera
 - \$1,557 for headsets for the language class to use when practicing listening and speaking. This grant was tabled for further review.
5. Art - Kalenbaugh
 - \$2,089.15 for drawing tablets so the students can have better equipment to help their drawings come to life. This grant was approved.
