The <u>Valencia Horizon Scholars – Take Stock in Children Program</u> is a scholarship, mentoring, and college readiness program designed to provide students with professional, academic, and personal support. This program culminates in students receiving a **two-year Florida Prepaid scholarship that can be used at any public university, college, or vocational/technical school in Florida upon high school graduation and successful program completion**. The application window is currently open and closes on March 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2023.

## **Student Eligibility Requirements:**

- Have a 2.5 unweighted GPA
- Meet the household financial need requirements as outlined in the attached documents and our website
- Demonstrate a desire to continue their education after high school

- Mentorship throughout High School
- College & Career Readiness Support
- A College Success Coach
- Personal, Academic, & Leadership Development
