

# Resources for Practicing Spanish at Home

## ***Online Resources:***

- **iStation**- Available to all Dual Language students K-5. Students can practice their reading skills and comprehension in Spanish. Students log in through [launch.ocps.net](http://launch.ocps.net)
- **Duolingo**- This is an app that you can use while that can be done in 5 minute or less sessions.
- **Read Conmigo**- <https://www.readconmigo.org/>
  - This is an online library of books in Spanish you can read with your child. It can also be downloaded as an app for your personal device.
