- Register for SAT/ACT *talk to your counselor about fee waiver eligibility
- Create professional personal email for college/career applications -CHECK DAILY!
- Start applying for college using Common App, Coalition App, or college's internal application.
- o Build college interest list
- Visit colleges campuses and take an in person tour if possible.
- Connect to your SCOIR account and register for on campus college visits.
- Review college application essay prompts and brainstorm ideas.
- Create/Login to College Board "Big Future" and search colleges, majors, and careers.

- Start writing essay and ask for editing and proofreading help.

- Continue strong commitment to academics - colleges <u>DO</u> look at your 7th semester grades!
- Track any honors college and school specific merit based scholarship deadlines.
- Send official test scores to your colleges from your College Board/ACT account.
- Start researching and applying for community based scholarships.
- Submit applications with Dec. 1 deadlines BEFORE Thanksgiving break.
- Track financial aid offer acceptance deadlines.

DECEMBER 1

REGULAR DECISION DEADLINES

DECEMBER 31

SUBMIT Community Service/Paid Work hours to Counselor.

- Read all admissions information for important action deadlines.
- Carefully compare financial aid offers from colleges.
- Notify Mrs. Maroth in the CCC of all admissions acceptances and financial aid awards.
- Study for end of semester exams.
- Continue researching and applying for community based scholarships.
- Submit applications with Jan. 1 deadlines.

SUBMIT Community Service/Paid Work hours to Counselor.

- Update FAFSA application profile, if needed.
- Consider a financial aid appeal if your family's financial situation has changed since initial application.

- Continue researching scholarships.
